

# MINUTES

## **Marvin Ridge Band Boosters General Membership Meeting**

*September 3, 2009*

The meeting was called to order by Karen Lacy at 7:06 p.m.

### **Treasurer's Report**

Mary Carolyn Titus presented the Balance Sheet/Income Statement. The current balance in the Band Booster Accounts is \$26,753.00. Income of \$25,246.00 was brought in from band camp, Band Booster Membership fees (31 families have joined), Band shirt sales (marching band and middle school), Method Book Sales, and Direct Public Support. Expenses paid out for the period totaled \$15,047.00 which included Operation expenses, Sales Tax fees, Middle School Band Expenses, High School Band Expenses, Instrumental Program Expense and Marching Band expenses. Leaving Net income of \$10,199.00. Treasurer's report was accepted and put onto the record. A full copy of report is hereby attached to these minutes.

### **Marching Band Shirt Orders**

Denise Wahlers presented the final order form for show shirt, hoodies and polo spirit wear orders. PayPal account has not been setup so all orders will be paid for with checks. Pit Crew and Band Booster shirts will be the same Polos with the same embroidered logo. Pit Crews shirts will say Pit Crew on sleeve. In order for the shirts to be ready for the Preview all sizes will have to be in by Tuesday, September 8<sup>th</sup>.

### **Marching Band Competitions**

Mary Carolyn Titus stated that registrations have been sent for Central Cabarrus and North Davidson competitions. She also stated that she needed the time sheets for band camp staff so that they could be paid.

### **Union County Band Preview**

Karen Lacy stated that she had talked with Mrs. Fisenne of MRHS concerning police officers and janitors. The original fee of \$295.00 for janitors was high. Keith James stated that last year they were paid additional fee for locking up which wouldn't be needed this year. Athletic Boosters had been contacted and were aware of event. A meeting was called for September 15<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. to finalize and go over preview event. Volunteers are still needed. A director's packet needs to be put together. Keith James stated that he would get the information for that together. A Drum O'Meter still needed to be purchased at an approximate cost of \$130.00.

### **New Business**

Jennifer Isenhour and Keith James stated that they are still in need of a couple of instruments for this semester. A Tenor Sax and a base clarinet. Mary Carolyn Titus stated that \$3500.00 has been budgeted for the middle school and \$500.00 for the high school.

### **Fruit Sales:**

Gwen McClendon had contacted the fruit sales company. All orders must be in by November 14<sup>th</sup>. She inquired when Mr. James wanted to start and end the sale. It was decided that the last two week of October would probably be best. Mrs. McClendon was going to contact the company concerning brochures and safety rules for students. She would finalize the dates as soon as she had received all necessary information.
